

DAYTONA BEACH, FL (February 10, 2010) – Jennifer Jo Cobb hit the track for the first time with her new NASCAR Camping World Truck Series team. Piloting the No. 10 Driven for Men Ford F-150, Cobb took her initial laps around the 2.5-mile Daytona International Speedway in preparation for Friday night's NextEra Energy Resources 250. Cobb's results from the practice session have the Kansas City, KS., native optimistic about the race to come.

In accordance with team manager Mike Harmon's instructions, Cobb filled the practice session by making single-truck runs. Cobb's best time was 51.557 seconds.

"We're off to a good start," said Cobb regarding the practice session. "On our first few laps, the truck was traveling too much. It was bottoming out and really disrupting the handling. I felt like we weren't getting up to speed because it was jumping around. My crew made some changes that have helped it a lot. The balance was much better after we had a chance to work on it. We have one more practice session before we qualify tomorrow night, so we'll make a few adjustments that will make it even better."

Final practice for the NextEra Energy Resources 250 begins at 9:00 AM February 11, followed by qualifying at 6:10 PM. The green flag will start the race at 8:00 PM on Friday. Coverage can be seen on SPEED TV.
