

DAYTONA BEACH, FL (February 11, 2010) – Jennifer Jo Cobb will start the NextEra Energy Resources 250 from the 28<sup>th</sup> position. The No. 10 Driven Ford F-150 circled the 2.5-mile Daytona International Speedway in 52.038 seconds (172.951 mph) on her qualifying lap, securing her spot on the outside of row 14. Based on her practice session this morning, Cobb is excited about her chances to end tomorrow's race at the front of the pack.

"I can't wait for tomorrow," said Cobb. "My team has worked so hard on my truck this week. All of their hours are paying off. It drives great in traffic and sucks up well, everything a driver wants in a race truck. I'm not worried about our starting position. I know I have a truck that can get me up front. I'll look for a few friends to work with tomorrow; we'll partner up and make our way to the front. With a little luck, we'll avoid trouble and have a great day."
